<u>AT YOUR VISIT – PLEASE HELP US BY</u>

- Wearing a face mask in the clinical areas and use of the hand gel supplied.
- Bringing DISTANCE GLASSES (for your visual test).
- Bringing your APPOINTMENT LETTER.
- Prepare for waiting times by bringing a suitable snack or medication.
- If you are under 16 years, please come along with a parent or guardian.
- Prepare for the possibility of requiring eye drops as driving is NOT recommended afterwards. We cannot assume in advance whether or not you will need drops.
- If you require additional support to attend, please come accompanied if possible.



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
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• Eye drops are required to make your pupils big enough to see the back of your eye(s). You will be asked to wait for an additional 20 minutes in the waiting area for these to work and then you will be called back in to finish your exam. ALL SLIT LAMP AND OCT APPOINTMENTS WILL REQUIRE EYE DROPS.

PLEASE CONTACT US AND RESCHEDULE YOUR APPOINTMENT IF YOU ARE FEELING ILL OR THINK YOU MAY BE EXPERIENCING SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19.

INVERNESS APPOINTMENTS TAKE PLACE AT THE CENTRE FOR HEALTH SCIENCE COMPLEX

Once in the hospital grounds – follow signs for "Centre for Health Science". There is a separate car park at this building which requires you to purchase a £1 token – as this complex is not governed by the NHS. The charge is also applicable to disabled badge holders. Token machines are located at the exits within the building. The Raigmore hospital car park remains free of charge however, there is a slight walk over to the Centre for Health Science building from there.
